Appellation: Margaret River, Western Australia
Varietal/Vineyards: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
Harvested: April 2021
Alc/Vol: 14.0%
Closure: Stelvin Lux +
Optimal Drinking: A delicious wine to drink young for its primary fruit characters. The wine will gain complexity and smoothness with cellaring 5 to 8 years.

Season: The 2021 vintage in Margaret River was a cool, wet & challenging one. A battle from start to finish, with very tricky weather conditions to manage picking around. It was ultimately rewarding with delicate Cabernet showcasing typical Regional characteristics.

Our thoughts on the wine: Distinctive Margaret River regional Cabernet Sauvignon aromas, softer red berry and plum characters and delicate fruit tannins on the finish.



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
