

There's an edge of very ripe, dark-plum paste and prunes to the nose here with plenty of spice in behind. The palate has dense, ripe dark berries and plums, in a thickish tannin frame. Drink now Screw cap.

James Suckling WA Wine Tasting 2020 The Mount Barker tradition with Shiraz may not be as well known as others in Australia, but this complex, enticingly scented midweight red stakes a convincing claim to the fine-wine high ground. It's dark but not saturatedly deep in colour; precise and enchanting floral scents and sweet spices rather than sumo-like fruit dominate the aromatic profile. The palate brings those floral and spice notes together once again, and it's just a spoonful or two of tar and earth rather than tannin which bring complexity to the pomegranate and damson fruits. Soft, naturally articulated acidity completes the happy picture.

Vivacious and youthful colour, bright purple from centre to rim. Savoury and spicy aromatics of rhubarb, pepper, dried herbs and toasty oak. There's freshness and vitality when sipped - purple berries afford it sweetness and charm. Only just a little more than medium-weight. Cool climate, Rhôney pepper, and sapidity. Terrific winemaking.

Fruit off two sites in Wallcliffe and Karridale, hand-picked, whole-bunch pressed, wild fermentation but no malo, in French oak, 50% new, and on lees 7 months. The sweet oak is apparent and needs to calm down to allow the fruit to come to the fore. Hint of peach, pink grapefruit, lots of spicy nuances and flavoursome, with a palate that's not mean but certainly lean from the shot of acidity. Appealing though.
